We are able to offer our patients robotic knee and hip replacement. minimally invasive same day spine surgery, arthroscopic shoulder, knee, and hip joint preservation surgery, minimally invasive bunionectomies, in office vein ablations, and robotic assisted obstetric surgery to name just a few."

all of us, and medical offices were no exception. As an essential service, One Oak Medical remained open but limited the number of patients seen at any given time. At the peak of the crisis, when hospitals were being overwhelmed with patients, One Oak Medical established Orthopedic Urgent Care centers in Wayne and Clifton to help reduce the number of people that needed to go to an emergency room for injuries. Dr. Mahmood says, "Those injuries and conditions which required urgent surgical intervention were taken to our surgical centers to minimize risk of exposure to COVID and we were able to safely treat many fractures, spine injuries, and lacerations this way." The group also established a program to offer free COVID-19 antibody tests to first responders, including doctors, nurses, EMT's, firefighters and police officers. "The response was overwhelming and we ended up seeing over 400 first responders," says Dr. Mahmood, adding, "It was great that we could help provide those people and their families some much needed piece of mind.

Aside from providing top notch medical care, the physicians at One Oak Medical also believe that giving back to the community is very important. Dr. Mahmood says, "As health care providers we believe it to be our moral duty to give back and many of our doctors and staff participate in food drives, support women's and children's shelters and help raise money for cancer and animal welfare organizations. Often our physicians donate their time to provide free services to local hospitals through their clinics that serve the uninsured and underinsured. Additionally, several of our doctors have been privileged to serve in medical missions, both domestic and foreign."
